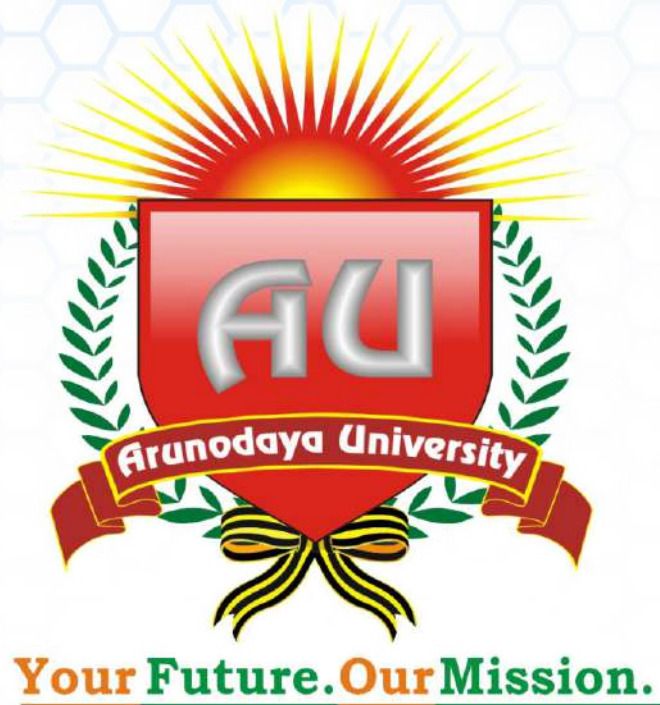

The University has been incorporated with an objective of providing quality education supplemented with industrial internship and professional training in the areas of business & management, engineering & technology, training & development, computing & information technology, entrepreneurship, rural development, media & communication, basic and varied branches of science, humanities, juridical sciences, liberal art & sciences, performing arts, quality training & development of civil servant officials etc.

Arunodaya University comes under section 2(f) of UGC act which empowers it to award degrees specified in section 22 of UGC act of 1956. 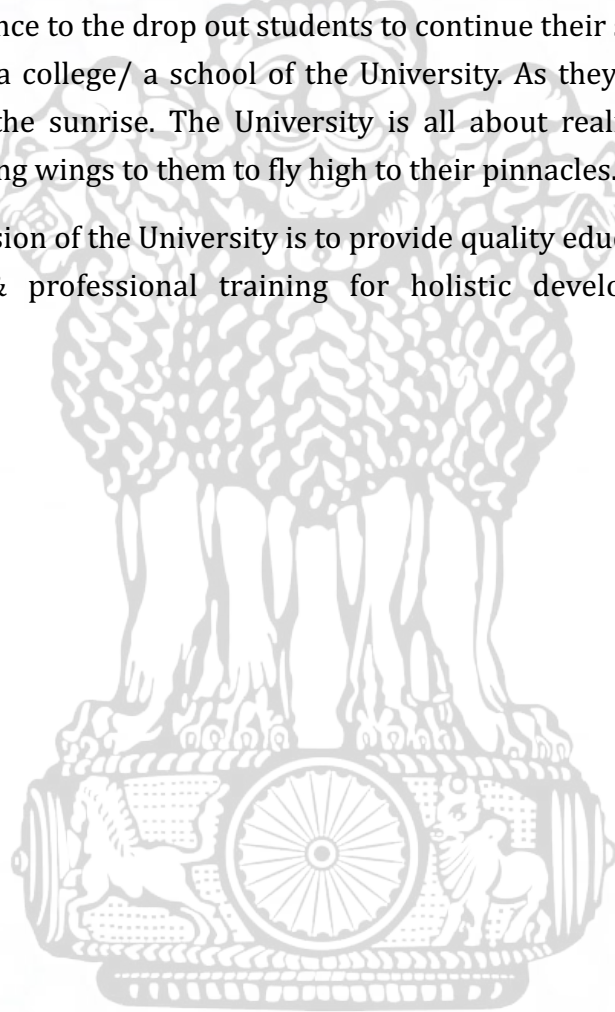
The University will also focus on skill development programs with in-hand training to ensure employability of outgoing students in tune with the current policy of the government of India to provide proper training for employability of the youth.

The Department of Geography, Arunodaya University, conducted a field study by MA 3rd Semester students as a part of their practical for the paper "MAGEO 305: Field Work and Project Report". The objective of the trip was to assess the Industrial visit and to prepare a project report for the same. The primitive purpose of the field work was to nurture learners to be acquainted with scholarly research and writing, under the supervision

of the esteemed faculty members/guides (Miss Merry Boko) in order to provide opportunity to apply their knowledge/skill acquired during their study in real life situation.

The curriculum of Post Graduate Geography of Arunodaya University comprises of twenty papers each carrying 100 marks. It is mandatory for an enrolled learner of this course to submit Field Report/Field Oriented Dissertation Report in partial fulfilment of the requirements for the award of degree of M.A. in Geography.

The trip was conducted for 4 days i.e., on 6th October 2023. A total of 14 students were part of this trip along with faculty of the department.

The trip started from university campus on 6th Nov, 2023 and arrived at Guwahati on 7th October, 2023.

The field trip started i.e., on 7th, students visited the Regional Meteorological Centre (RMC) Guwahati This gave students a great opportunity to experience and learn about the Weather Reports and Rainfall Information.

During the whole trip, the survey and interview was continued. Primary data was collected through this field trip. The methodology used to collect the primary data included observation method.

On the next day i.e., 8th October 2023 the students left for the North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC) Shillong.



Pakke Tiger Reserve On Flora And Fauna



Ms. Mery Boko, Asst. Professor cum HOD of the Department of Geography, Arunodaya University, Lekhi Village, Naharlagun, scheduled the field trip as part of the curriculum and to provide students hand-on experience with environmental study. The objective of the trip was to assess the flora and fauna in the study area and to prepare a project report for the same. The purpose of the field work was to nurture learners to be acquainted with scholarly research and writing,

under the supervision of the esteemed faculty members/guides (Shri. Kenli Ete and Dr. Shivlal Sharma) in order to provide opportunity to apply their knowledge/skill acquired during their study in real life situation, The flora and fauna are part of curriculum, so we have decided to go for one day field trip to Pakke Tiger Reserve to explore the flora and fauna.

Mr. Darshan Kumar and his colleague accompany us as guide for giving an overview of park and took us on beautiful tour discussing about the different species of flora and fauna of the Tiger reserve. The trip was enjoyable and educational for the 40 students who attended the trip.

Students learnt basic information about different species of fauna like, butterflies, spiders, insects, snakes and so on and the seasons in which they are active. We learned about the numerous trees that serve as host plants for the caterpillars to lay eggs on and consume the leaves of the host plant, as well as the nectarine plant, which provides them with their meal. The students also interacted with the guide about the various challenges and issues related to the Pakke Tiger reserve, like poaching, hunting, availability of tigers and the techniques use to track the tiger in the reserve.

Pakke Wildlife Sanctuary and Pakke Tiger Reserve falls in the Pakke Kessang district. Its Southern border merges with the inner line, State borderline between Assam and Arunachal. The tract of the protected area falls within the land area of Pakke river and Kameng river. It has an area of 861.95 Sq.Km with geographical variations of terai and rugged siwalik ranges. After a drive of about 3 hrs. from Itanagar through NH52 one reaches to a



point known as CHHAIBARI and the take a right turn, passing through the plains, tea gardens and newly devastated forest vegetation of Assam covering a distance of 28 Km comes Seijosa in Arunachal. It is the Divisional HQ of Pakke Wildlife Sanctuary. Seijosa, is a small rural village with some Govt. Establishments and settlements. The beauty of this place is that though there are settlements, establishments yet the rural look, the greenery persists. The air is clear free from dust and pollution. The Pakke river flows down through this area which ultimately meets with the Jiya varali in Assam.

On the west Bank through a small dam, crossing the river and a furlong through Nameri Wildlife Sanctuary of Assam you reach at the gate of Pakke Wildlife Sanctuary (861.95 Sq. Km). The establishment of Range Officer (Wildlife), Seijusa consists of the Range office, staff quarters, a Rest house of transit officers. There is one raised temporary shade ideal with the natural surroundings. A few displays of caged animals for the visitors have been kept. A road of 12 Km leads to a place known as Khari, a beat establishment with a transit accommodation deep inside the Sanctuary. The 12 Km fair weather road needs maintenance after a rainy season which is the only approach to the place Khari.



The population is quite optimum to support the population of tiger. At present there has no incident or report of hunting of animal due to correct approach taken by the Sanctuary authority. The village, which existed inside the sanctuary area, had been shifted to the other side of the Pakke River under Centrally Sponsored Scheme. This shifting and re-settlement was done with the total cooperation from the villagers.

There are more success stores in this part of wildlife areas. The tribal population used to wear the head-gear (cap) with the beak of hornbill. Even the meat of the bird was a delicacy to them. But with the motivation of the Sanctuary authority and with the help of local leader, an institutional outlook and norms have taken place. The tribal have decided not to hunt any animals or birds and a substitution of plastic made hornbill

Fishing of small fishes with hook and other country devices was a system of food collection of the poor mass from water bodies along the railways, roads etc. but now due to the different development process and expansion of urban areas the system has broken down. But here one can notice in the afternoon and evening the village women with a plate covered with cloth with a small hole are busy in fishing small fishes. An interesting role and technique they play for fishing, which is, sufficient for a day meal. Such river and watercourse is the lifeline of this natural system. The sources of such water bodies are the catchments, with in the Sanctuary.

The legal education in Arunachal Pradesh has been one of the most demanding and important field of study in the state. However, there has never been enough law colleges in the state to cater the need of the people. Further, the gap was widened when by notification JUD/DCS-37/2010 dated 6 January 2016 of Government of Arunachal Pradesh, Judiciary was formally separated from Executive. Thus, the Judicial Courts of Arunachal Pradesh were created along with the vacancies for judges and Law officers. To fill the void and to fulfil the aspiration of the people of Arunachal Pradesh, the Arunodaya University introduced the Department of Law at its Lekhi campus in the year 2019. The Department of Law was established in the year 2019 by Arunodaya University and is an accredited legal institution by the Bar Council of India for its LL.B. degree. Presently, the Department is imparting three years LL.B. course. LL.B. is a full-time professional course recognised and regulated by the Legal Education Rules 2008 of the Bar Council of India. In accordance with the BCI prescribed time for holding classes from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., classes for students of the department are conducted from 9 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

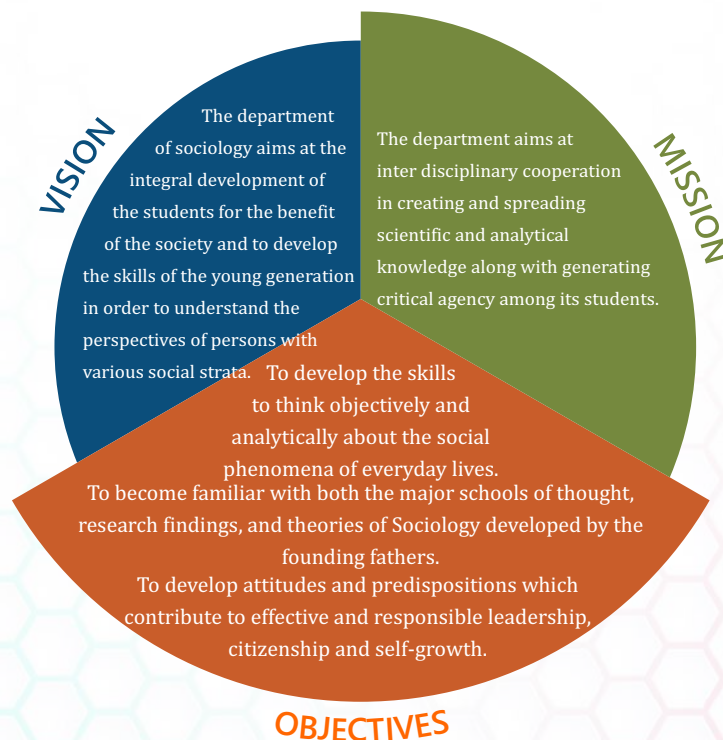

2) The students are required to be personally present at the time of allotment of Room. No preference of rooms will be entertained. Rooms must be occupied immediately after the allotment is made.

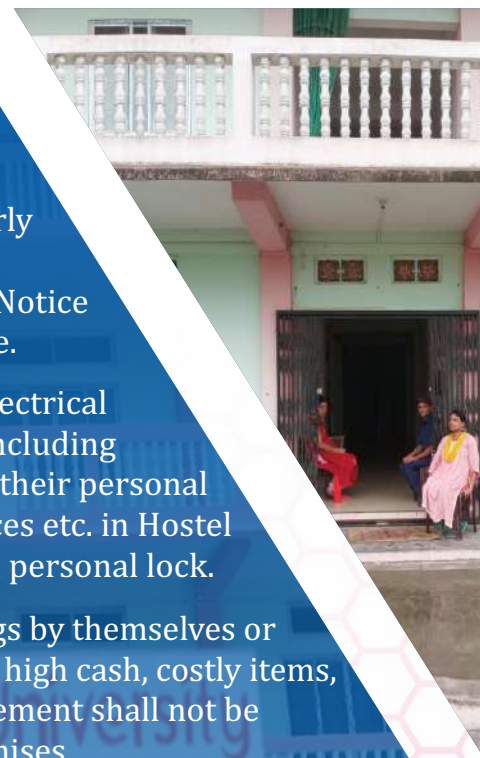

Hostellers are not permitted to keep their personal utensils such as Cups, plates, glasses, spoons, Jams, Spices etc. in Hostel Mess, They are also not allowed to lock their room with personal lock.

6) Hostellers are required to take care of their belongings by themselves or items issued to them. Hostellers are advised not to keep high cash, costly items, Jewellerys etc. inside the Hostel. The University management shall not be responsible for the loss of any belonging inside the premises.

7) The Hosteller's can only leave hostel including on holidays with the prior permission of Hostel Warden and Guardian.



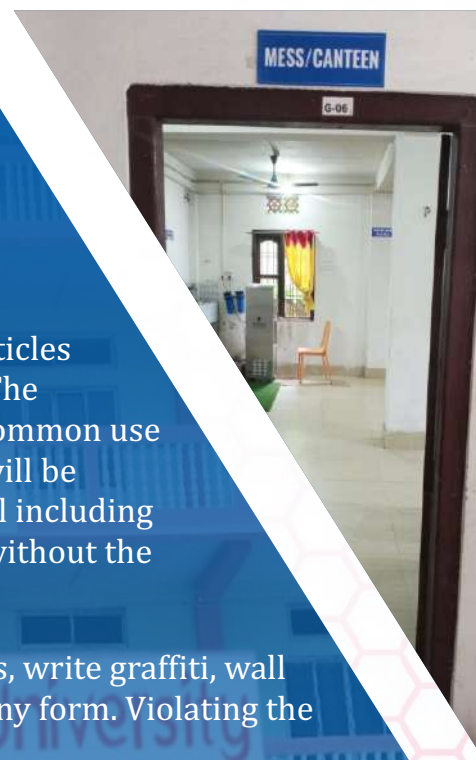
8) The Hostellers are liable to return the belongings of Hostel issued to them at the time of admission in good / original condition to the Hostel Warden at the time of vacating the Hostel. Damages made if any will be recovered from the Hosteller.



9) The Hostellers shall not damage hostel property, fittings, articles, items and property of other people inside the Hostel. In case of violation penal fee equivalent to five times of the amount of damage article including disciplinary action will be taken against the candidate. In case of such events where the culprit is not identified then the authority reserves its right to impose common fine on all the Hostellers.



10) The facilities like ironing of cloths are only permitted in designated area, if any (but not inside the room). The hostellers are not allowed to install/ pose Music System/ Speakers inside the rooms.



11) The Hostellers can use common rooms, recreation facilities, the newspapers, other allied literature and articles required for indoor games at designated timings only. The Hostellers are not allowed to carry articles meant for common use to their rooms. The timings to avail common facilities will be decided by the Hostel Warden. The belongings of Hostel including furniture cannot be shifted from one room to another without the permission of Hostel Warden

12) The Hostellers are requested to not to paste posters, write graffiti, wall chalking, slogans of any kind or defacing the hostel in any form. Violating the norms may invite penal as well as disciplinary action.

13) The Hostel Warden/ Authorities/ Management are empowered to make spot checks on the Hostel Rooms, bags & baggage's of the Hostellers to monitor and ensure strict compliance of hostel regulations.

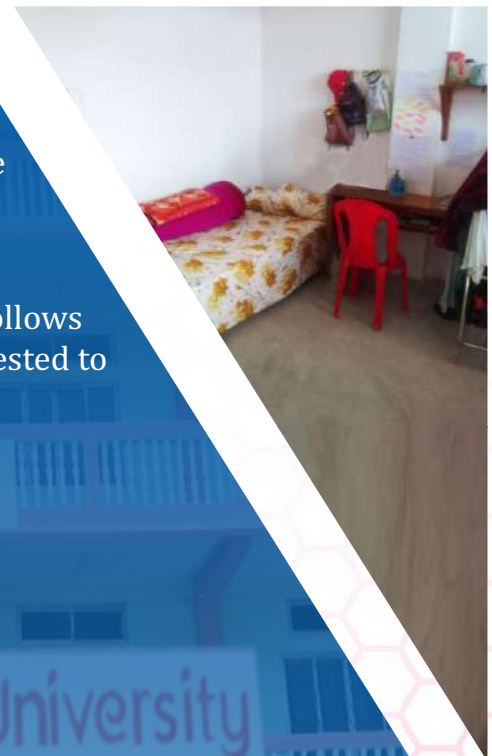


14) Hostel Residents are required to carry their Hostel ID Cards issued during admission always in the compound of the hostel complex and produce it on demand by the Hostel Authorities/ Management/ Security personnel.



15) Hostel Residents are not permitted to change the designated room even on temporary basis without the permission of Warden.

16) The electric appliances such as iron, oven, kettle, stove, hot plates etc. are strictly prohibited. If found the hosteller will face disciplinary action in addition to confiscation of such article.



17) The Hostels maintained by Arunodaya University follows strict environmental concerns. The Hostellers are requested to consume minimum amount of water and electricity.

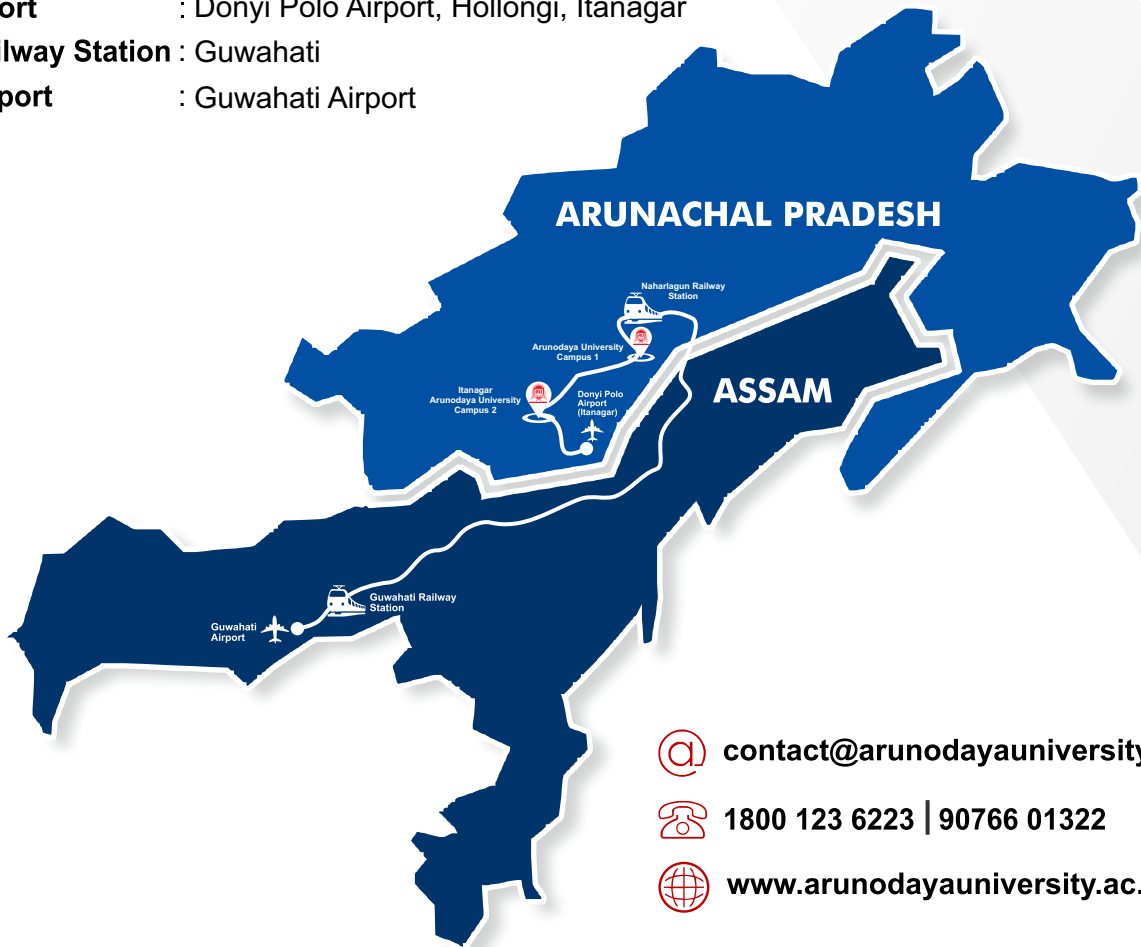
