Red Run Marathon

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Arunodaya University organized a **Red Run Marathon (5 km)** on **25th August 2025** at AU Campus Block-A, Lekhi Village. The event was conducted under the "Youth Festival" initiative of the **Arunachal Pradesh State AIDS Control Society**, under the aegis of **NACO**, **Ministry of Health and Family Welfare**, **Government of India.**

The primary objective of the marathon was to spread awareness and promote **comprehensive knowledge about HIV/AIDS prevention and control** in line with NACO guidelines and the National Family Health Survey.
