❖ OBSERVATIONS:

The keynote lecture provided a clear historical perspective and sparked questions on federalism and fundamental rights.

- Panelists linked constitutional provisions to digital privacy, environmental law, and social justice, generating lively debate.
- Cultural items reinforced the theme of unity in diversity.
- The quiz was well-received, with 80 % of participants answering correctly on key constitutional articles.

❖ OUTCOMES:

Post-event survey: 88 % of respondents reported increased understanding of the Constitution.

- Interest in the university's Constitutional Law Society rose, reflected in a 30 % increase in membership sign-ups.
- The event strengthened inter-year interaction among law students.

❖ CONCLUSION:

Schedule a similar event annually, possibly expanding to include a workshop on constitutional amendment procedures.

❖ RECOMMENDATIONS:

Schedule a similar event annually, possibly expanding to include a workshop on constitutional amendment procedures.

- Incorporate moot-court simulations on contemporary constitutional issues.
- Establish a permanent feedback system to guide future improvements.




