## About The Department

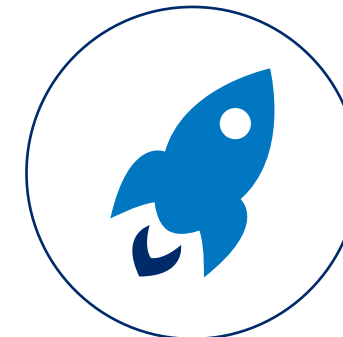

### M/S Millo Enterprises, Lekhi Village, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh

On 2nd May, 2025, a group of 44 students from the MBA and BBA programs visited M/s. Millo Enterprises, a paper bag manufacturing unit located in Lekhi Village, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh, as a part of Industrial exposure program to bridge academic learning with real-world industry practices.

During the visit, students were given a comprehensive overview of the company's operations, including raw material sourcing, manufacturing processes, quality control, packaging, and distribution. They also gained insights into the challenges and opportunities of running a sustainable, eco-friendly business in the North-Eastern region of India.



### Key learnings from the visit included:

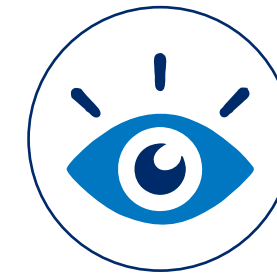

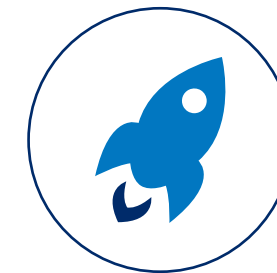

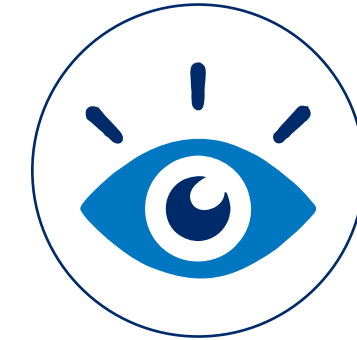

## About The Department

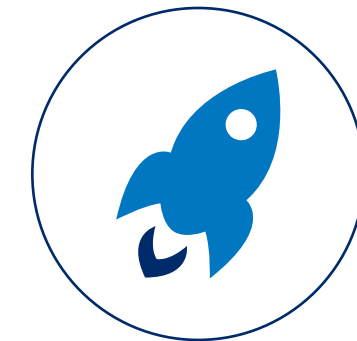

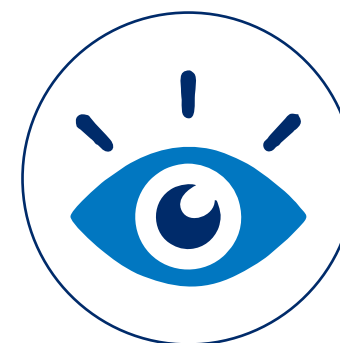

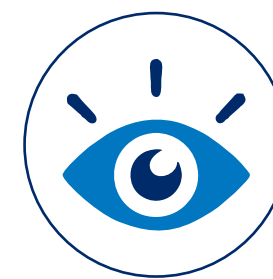
# DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

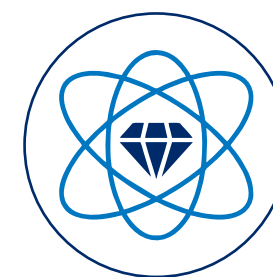

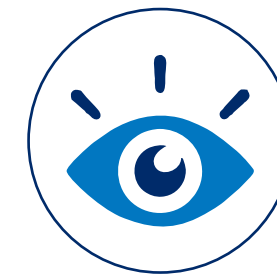

## About The Department

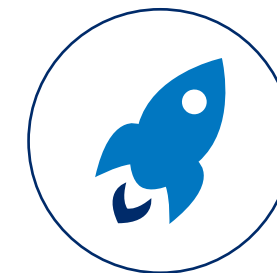

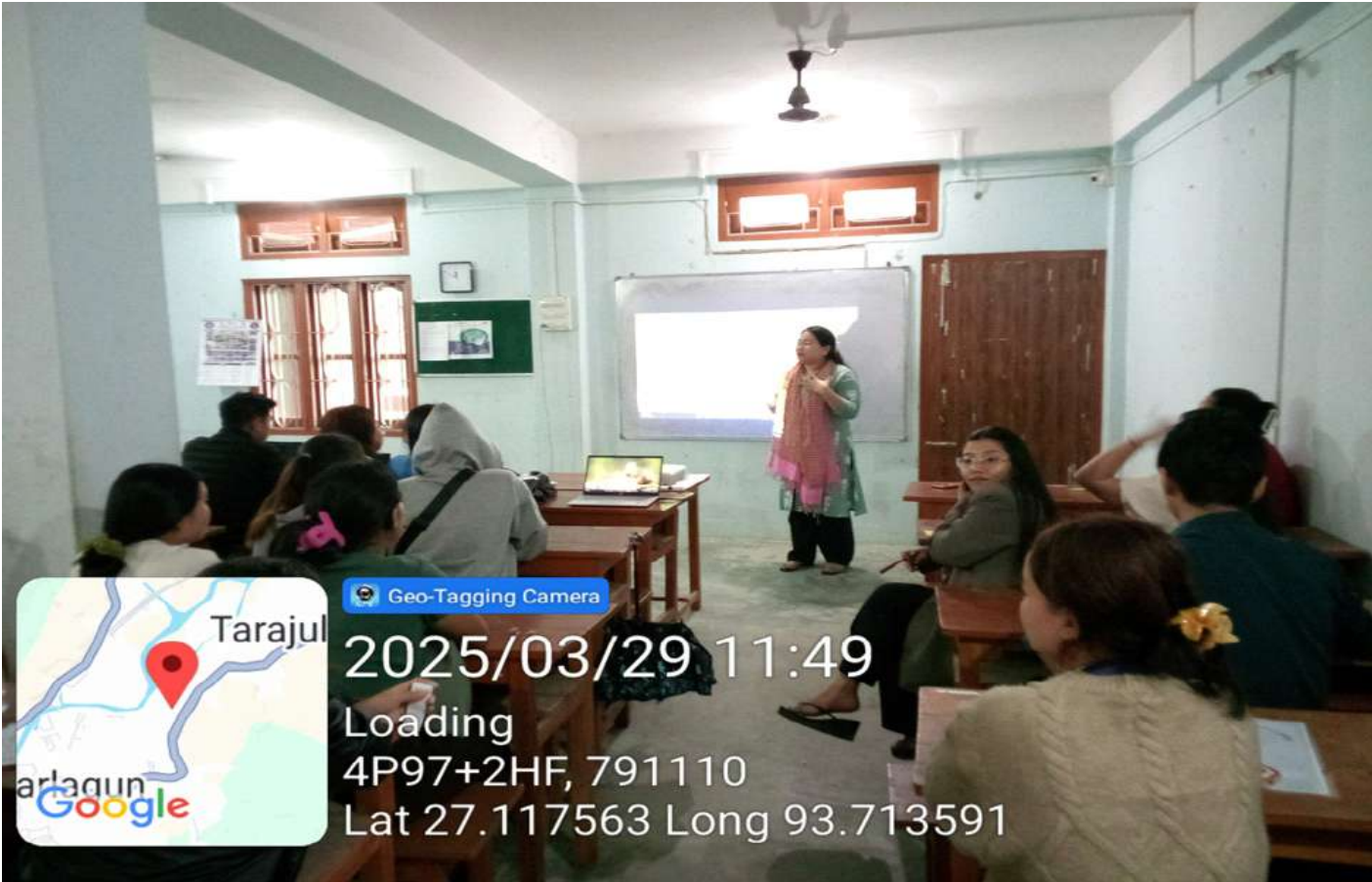
# VIDEO-MAKING NEWS PRESENTATION ON TRAFFIC PROBLEMS IN ITANAGAR

The Programme was Coordinated by Shri Mithlesh Kr. Shah NSS Coordinator , & ended with a group photo.

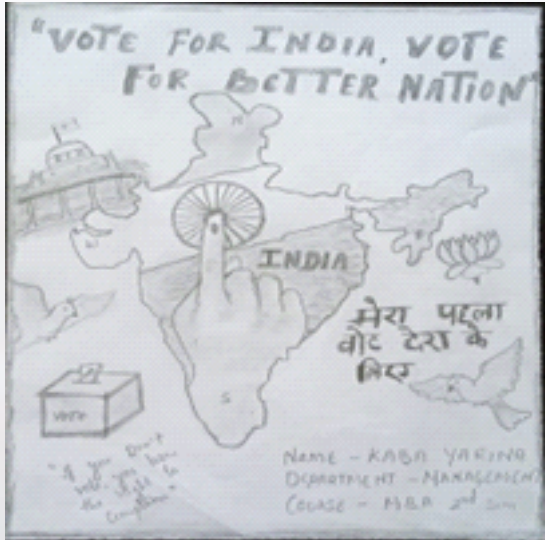

# HOSTEL FACILITY

1) Admissions into the hostels are subjected to the University Regulations. The Hostels can't be claimed as a matter of right. The preference will be given to first year students

2) The students are required to be personally present at the time of allotment of Room. No preference of rooms will be entertained. Rooms must be occupied immediately after the allotment is made.



5) The Hostellers are not permitted to cook food, use electrical appliances, carry inflammable items inside the hostel including inside their room. Hostellers are not permitted to keep their personal utensils such as Cups, plates, glasses, spoons, Jams, Spices etc. in Hostel Mess, They are also not allowed to lock their room with personal lock.

6) Hostellers are required to take care of their belongings by themselves or items issued to them. Hostellers are advised not to keep high cash, costly items, Jewelleries etc. inside the Hostel. The University management shall not be responsible for the loss of any belonging inside the premises.



3) Every Hosteller must acknowledge and strictly follow the Hostel Rule & Regulations. The deliberate/ ignorant violation of regulations will invite severe action from the authority including debarring from the use of hostel without refund of fee, imposing penal fee or taking appropriate legal action if deem necessary.

4) Hostellers must read the Hostel Notice Board regularly for important notices and instructions. The complaints regarding any notice/ circular previously displayed on Notice board will not be trained on the grounds of ignorance.



7) The Hosteller's can only leave hostel including on holidays with the prior permission of Hostel Warden and Guardian.

8) The Hostellers are liable to return the belongings of Hostel issued to them at the time of admission in good / original condition to the Hostel Warden at the time of vacating the Hostel. Damages made if any will be recovered from the Hosteller.

9) The Hostellers shall not damage hostel property, fittings, articles, items and property of other people inside the Hostel. In case of violation penal fee equivalent to five times of the amount of damage article including disciplinary action will be taken against the candidate. In case of such events where the culprit is not identified then the authority reserves its right to impose common fine on all the Hostellers.



10) The facilities like ironing of cloths are only permitted in designated area, if any (but not inside the room). The hostellers are not allowed to install / pose Music System/ Speakers inside the rooms.

11) The Hostellers can use common rooms, recreation facilities, the newspapers, other allied literature and articles required for indoor games at designated timings only. The Hostellers are not allowed to carry articles meant for common use to their rooms. The timings to avail common facilities will be decided by the Hostel Warden. The belongings of Hostel including furniture cannot be shifted from one room to another without the permission of Hostel Warden

12) The Hostellers are requested to not to paste posters, write graffiti, wall chalking, slogans of any kind or defacing the hostel in any form. Violating the norms may invite penal as well as disciplinary action.

13) The Hostel Warden/ Authorities/ Management are empowered to make spot checks on the Hostel Rooms, bags & baggage's of the Hostellers to monitor and ensure strict compliance of hostel regulations.



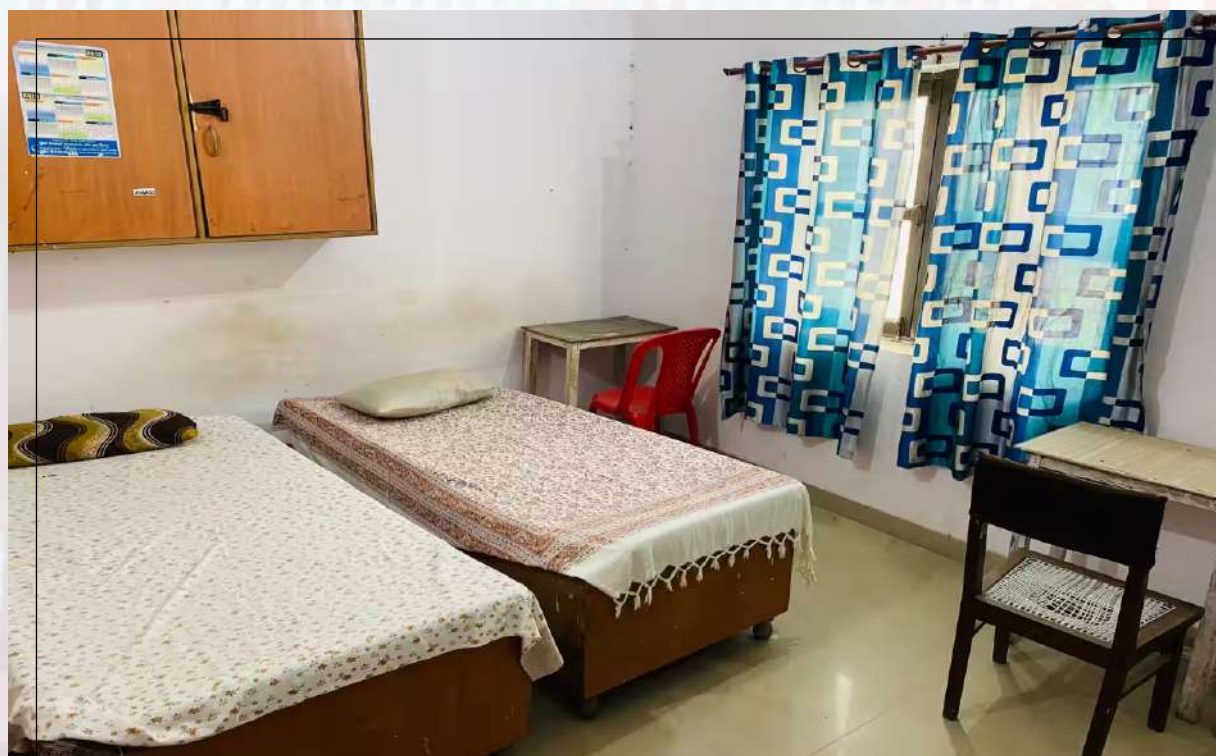


14) Hostel Residents are required to carry their Hostel ID Cards issued during admission always in the compound of the hostel complex and produce it on demand by the Hostel Authorities/ Management/ Security personnel.

15) Hostel Residents are not permitted to change the designated room even on temporary basis without the permission of Warden.

16) The electric appliances such as iron, oven, kettle, stove, hot plates etc. are strictly prohibited. If, found the hosteller will face disciplinary action in addition to confiscation of such article.

17) The Hostels maintained by Arunodaya University follows strict environmental concerns. The Hostellers are requested to use appropriate amount of water and electricity.

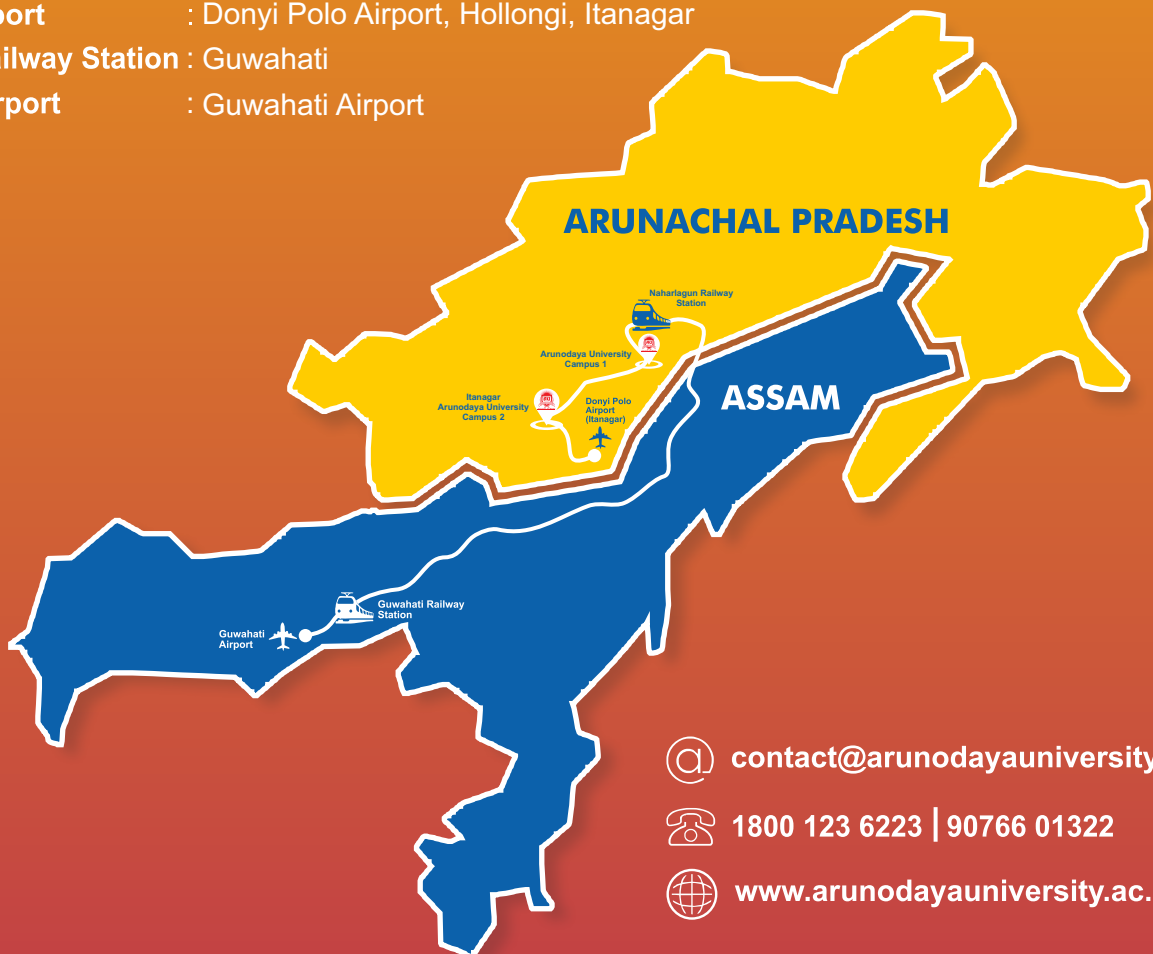
